CONTRACTING WITH TERRI DUNCAN AS FISCAL OFFCER FOR THE VILLAGE OF TREMONT CITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tremont, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That I, Terri Duncan, is hereby contracted as Fiscal Office for the Village of Tremont City starting January 1, 2025 thru December 31, 2025.

Terms of Contract

The above appointment to, and acceptance of fiscal officer for the Village of Tremont City, Ohio, is made under the following terms:

- 1) Mrs. Duncan will assume the position and related authority and responsibilities of the fiscal officer, including taking meeting minutes, answering correspondence, filing reports, office work, paying bills, writing ordinances, depositing funds, coordinating for audits, and any other duties as outlined in the ORC.
- 2) The village of Tremont City shall provide compensation in the amount of \$600 monthly, \$300 to be paid on the 15^{th} and \$300 to be paid on the 30^{th} .
- 3) Either party may cancel this Contract by giving a written notice to the other party thirty (30) days prior to such cancellation.
- 4) The village shall provide bonding insurance for the position of fiscal officer.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
