

ORDINANCE 2024-14

Public Streets and Sidewalks

Whereas; Finding this ordinance as being an emergency for the health, welfare, and safety of the village residents and the public at large, this ordinance is being presented for immediate implementation and vote. It is therefore ordered that all public streets and sidewalks in the Village shall remain free of blockages, equipment, unhitched trailers, and all other hazards at all times; unless actively loading or unloading.

Wherefore; violation of this ordinance shall be a minor misdemeanor and subject to a fine of \$500 for the first offense and \$1000 each offense thereafter. Enforcement of this law will be restricted to the police chief and those officers that have been specifically authorized.
