SAFETY: Motion to sell LIDAR that is not used by Tony Flood, second by Vicki Jenkins; 4 yeas; motion passes.

STREETS: Tony Flood presented estimate for \$13,540 for installation of new traffic controller. A lease in the rears for 48 months would be \$3,931.80 per year with \$1 payment at the end. Motion to obtain new traffic controller from Security Fence by Steve Heider, second by Vicki Jenkins; 4 yeas motion passes. Motion to secure lease with Banc Corp. to finance traffic controller for 48 months at \$3,931.80 per year for four years with a \$1 purchase price at the end of the lease by Tony Flood, second by Steve Heider; 4 yeas; motion passes.
