

ORDINANCE 2024-17 AMENDMENT TO 2007-06

Curfew

Whereas; it is necessary to properly protect the health, safety and welfare of the minors of the Village of Tremont City, Ohio, and those minors in the Village, but not residents

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) to be present upon any public street, alley, park or other public place in the Village between thirty (30) minutes after sunset to thirty (30) minutes before sunrise unless;
  - 1. Accompanied by a parent, guardian, employer or some other person of legal age having charge of the minor's lawful care, custody and control;
  - 2. Returning home by direct route from and within thirty (30) minutes after a school activity, an activity of religious or supervised voluntary association, such as scouts, 4-H, community leagues or other community events;
  - 3. Is in a place or returning home from such place, connected with and required by some legitimate business, trade, profession or occupation in which the minor is permitted by law to be engaged.
- (b) Each parent or legal guardian of a minor child shall have a duty to prohibit the child from behaving contrary to section (a) of this ordinance. No person shall negligently fail to fulfill the duty imposed by this section.
- (c) Any minor who violates section (a) this ordinance is an unruly child and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court.
- (d) Any parent or legal guardian that violates this ordinance shall be sent a letter from the Chief of Police, detailing the curfew ordinance and subsequent penalties for additional violations. Additional violations will result in the parent or guardian being cited into Magistrate Court for violations of this ordinance, a misdemeanor of the 4<sup>th</sup> – fourth degree punishable by a fine of \$250 - \$5,000.
